1. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that, besides various reasons assigned in the application, the Court may consider appreciating that there are seven arbitration proceedings which are being conducted simultaneously. Accordingly, he prays for 18 month extension with effect from 03.08.2025.
