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1. Learned SPC appearing physically along with the Assistant Controller appearing through video conferencing submits that in the peculiar facts and circumstances involved herein it is in the interest of justice if the appellant is granted a fresh/ *de novo* hearing for due and proper adjudication of the patent application no.201717015945.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has no objection if the present proceedings are remanded for adjudication by the respondent after giving a fresh/ *de novo* hearing to the appellant.
