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1. Affidavit of service has been filed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states at bar that the copy of the petition was duly supplied to the learned counsel appearing for the respondent on 11.09.2024. However, despite service, none has chosen to appear.
3. The present petition has been filed for transfer of matrimonial case bearing HMA no. 470/2018 under section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act titled as *Yogesh Bajaj v. Neha Bajaj* pending before the court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Central, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the following litigations between the parties are pending before Dwarka Court:-
 - a) Petition under section 12 of the PWDV Act
 - b) FIR bearing no. 0921/2020 registered at P.S. Binda Pur under sections 498A/406/34 IPC



c) Execution criminal no. 258/2023 in Domestic Violence Act.

9. Both the parties are directed to appear before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, South-West, Dwarka Courts, Delhi on 03.03.2025.
10. The present petition along with pending application, stands disposed of.
