ORDER

1. The present Appeal has been filed by the Appellants under Order XLIII Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 [hereinafter referred to as the "CPC"] read with Section 10 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 and Chapter II Rule 2 of the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018 assailing the correctness of the order dated 25.07.2025 passed in CS(OS) 470/2019 captioned ***Raj Vidya Kender (RVK) & Anr. vs. Satya Prakash Ravidas & Ors.***

2. The order dated 25.07.2025 reads as under:

"1. This application is filed by the Plaintiffs under Sections 2(b), 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against Defendant No. 1 for non-compliance of orders dated 19.07.2023 and 10.04.2024.

2. Issue notice.

3. Defendant No. 1 who is present in Court accepts notice and seeks and is granted two weeks to file the reply.

4. Copy of the application has been handed over to Defendant No. 1 in Court.



5. List on 26.08.2025.”

3. The learned Single Judge has only issued Notice to the Appellants, which has been accepted by them and time has been sought for filing a reply. Such an order is not appealable before this Court. Moreover, the Appellants have failed to show any prejudice before this Court.

4. Hence, the Appeal, along with pending application, is dismissed.
