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1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* to the respondents for production of *corpus* – Ms. 'R' before this Court.
