1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months for making and publishing the award.
2. It is stated that the delay occurred on account of the change of the arbitrator and the delay attributable to the respondent.
3. For the said reasons, issue notice.
