2. The medical documents filed along with the present petition indicates that the petitioner has been suffering from neurological ailments for many years.
3. The same, at this stage, indicates that the petitioner had been suffering from the same neurological ailments when released on furlough on earlier occasions.
4. Considering the above, the same does not appear to be a condition of such nature which would not allow the petitioner to surrender.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of granting liberty purely on humanitarian grounds, directing the



petitioner to surrender within a period of one week.
