ORDER

21.11.2025

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1. Petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 read with section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the Petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No. 0825/2014 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at P.S. Begm Pur, Delhi and all the proceedings emanating therefrom in terms of the Settlement dated 26.08.2025.
2. It is submitted that the first marriage of Petitioner No.1-husband with Respondent No.2-wife was solemnized on 19.06.1998 as per Hindu Rites and Customs and a child was born out of their wedlock.
3. It is stated that on 06.08.2014, the basis of complaint filed by the Respondent No. 2, FIR No. 0825/2014 was registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at P.S. Begum Pur wherein the Petitioners were implicated.
4. The parties are present in person in the Court and have been identified by their respective Counsel and the Investigating Officer.



5. It is submitted that with the intervention of family members, relatives and well wishers, Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 have resolved their disputes and arrived at an amicable settlement, terms whereof have been recorded in Settlement dated 26.08.2025.
6. It is submitted that the parties have now remarried on 29.07.2022 and living together happily since then and no grievance against each other survives.
7. It is submitted by the parties that they have arrived at a settlement without any force, coercion and undue influence and pressure and they have signed the Settlement dated 26.08.2025 voluntarily with their wish and will.
8. Learned Counsel for Petitioners submits that the parties have been happily living since 29.07.2022 and since Respondent No.2 has already made a statement before the Court that she does not want to pursue the proceedings in FIR No. 0825/2014, the present Petition be allowed and FIR registered against the Petitioners be quashed.
9. Respondent No.2 is present and submits that she has no grievance against the Petitioners and also 'no objection' to the quashing of FIR. She affirms that she is happily living together with Petitioner No.1.
10. In view of the fact that the FIR in question was premised upon a matrimonial dispute between Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2, which has been amicably resolved in term of Settlement dated 26.08.2025 and the fact that parties have been living together since they remarried on 29.07.2022 and also that Respondent No.2 has given 'no objection' to the quashing of FIR, no fruitful purpose would be served in continuing with the proceedings arising out of the FIR.
11. Consequently, FIR No. 0825/2014 registered under Sections



498A/406/34 IPC at P.S. Begum Pur and proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed.

12. The present Petition alongwith pending Applications, is accordingly disposed of.
