1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 55675/2025(Exemption)

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition under Section 10 and Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, seeks the following prayers:-

- “a) Take cognizance of the grave civil contempt committed by the Respondent/Contemnor through his willful and contumacious disobedience of the final order dated 03.11.2023;
b) Issue notice to the Respondent/Contemnor and conduct an



inquiry by initiating proceedings for contempt of court against them under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971;

c) Hold the Respondent/Contemnor guilty of contempt and punish them in accordance with the law;

d) Issue a peremptory direction to the Respondent/Contemnor to purge the contempt by complying with the directions in the order dated 03.11.2023 forthwith; and

e) Pass any other or further order(s), including imposition of exemplary costs to be recovered personally from the Respondent/Contemnor, as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings, if available, in accordance with law before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

5. Leave and liberty granted.

6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
