He has no power to interfere in the day to day affairs of any society. Each and every society has to follow its own rules & regulations duly registered with the Registrar of Societies. The Registrar of Societies has also not been vested with any control or supervisory power to hold the election of the Executive Committee of the Societies and the Registrar has no jurisdiction to hear & decide in summary manner any doubt or dispute in a registered society. The dispute, if any, is required to be settled at an appropriate forum.
