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1. Counsel for the plaintiff and defendant no.1 submit that the plaintiff and defendant no.1 have settled their disputes in mediation proceedings before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre ('Mediation Centre').

2. The Settlement Agreement dated 17th April, 2025 (hereinafter 'Settlement Agreement'), which bears the signatures of the authorised representatives of the plaintiff and the defendant no.1, has been placed on record.

3. I have perused the terms of the Settlement Agreement and do not find anything unlawful therein.

4. The parties shall remain bound by the terms of the Settlement
