“a) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/order/direction directing Respondents No. 1 & 2 to provide immediate police protection to the Petitioners to safeguard their life and liberty from Respondents No. 3 and their associates;

b) Issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction , directing Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to forthwith provide round-the-clock police protection , including but not limited to deployment of Personal Security Officers ( PSOs) or a mobile patrol unit, to the Petitioners and their minor son at their residence and during movements, to safeguard against any harm or threat from Respondent Nos. 3-9, and their associates, and /or;”

3. The learned ASC (Crl) appearing on behalf of the State submits that there is no threat perception in the present case. It is also stated that the phone



numbers of the concerned SHO and Beat Constable and the concerned officers have already been provided to the petitioners herein.

4. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that she does not want to press the present petition.

5. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
