ORDER

1. By the present petition, the petitioner challenges the order dated 10.05.2024, passed by the learned District Judge-01, South West, Dwarka Courts, pursuant to which his application under Order IX Rule 7 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC) for setting aside the order passed by the learned Trial Court proceeding *ex parte* against the petitioner, was dismissed.
