This is an application filed by the petitioner seeking permission to file lengthy list of dates and events with the writ petition.

For the reasons stated, the application is allowed.

W.P.(C) 13991/2025

1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition challenging an order dated 14.07.2025, by which the respondent has imposed the penalty of removal from service upon him.
2. The penalty order is admittedly amenable to appeal under Rule 23 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965. However, Mr. Raghavendra Bajaj, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has also approached this Court in W.P.(C) 3546/2024, *inter alia* seeking a declaration that he is deemed to



have voluntarily retired from the service of the respondent with effect from 17/18.12.2020.

3. Mr. Bajaj further submits that, in the present case, the proceedings are predicated on interrelated charges.

4. It is made clear that the petitioner may proceed in appeal without prejudice to his rights and contentions in W.P.(C) 3546/2024.

5. The petition is disposed of with these directions.
