B. Direct that adequate compensation/damages be paid by the Respondent in light of the substantial delay in compliance of Order dated 18.05.2025 in W.P. (C.) No. 6879 of 2025, titled as Sandeep Tandon & Anr. v. Delhi Developmental Authority.

C. Actual cost of the Present Petition; and

D. Pass any such other order that this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

4. Learned counsel for the respondent, on advance notice, submits that the



directions given in order dated 21.05.2025 in W.P.(C) 6879/2025 have been complied with.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.

6. Leave granted.

7. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
