O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 759/2025

1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a further period of twelve months to make and publish the final Award.
2. It is stated that the matter is at the advanced stage and is listed for rejoinder arguments and that some delay was caused because of respondent's inability to pay the arbitral fee. Hence, the delay.
