1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks following prayers:-

“a) summon and punish contemnors for willful & deliberate disobedience of Final order dated 28.07.2025 passed by this Hon'ble Court in Writ Petition (C) No.10920/2025; and/or

b) direct WRC and its officials to comply with final order dated 28.07.2025 passed by this Hon'ble Court in Writ Petition (C) No.10920/2025 and issue order of restoration of recognition of B .Ed course and also to update the status of petitioner institute as recognized institution for running B.Ed course and their official website and also to communicate the recognized status to affiliating University and Govt. of Gujarat enabling petitioner institute to participate in counselling and admit students in B.Ed course during present academic year 2025-26 and subsequent years; and/or

c) pass any such other orders/directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”



3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that upon filing of the present petition, the order dated 28.07.2025 in W.P.(C) 10920/2025 has been complied with by the respondent.
4. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
5. Leave granted.
6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
