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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers:-

“(i) Issue a Writ in the nature of Certiorari and / or any other appropriate Writ/Order or Direction Quashing/setting aside the ex-parte Judgement dated 01.12.2023 passed by the add. District and Sessions Judge-cum- Presiding Officer of Labour Court-V (POLC-V), Rouse Avenue court, New Delhi, in industrial dispute bearing case no. 465/2020, titled "*Mr. Ashok Kumar vs. Mis. New Friends Club*";
(ii) Pass any other order (s) which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case in favour of the Petitioners and against the Respondent.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the matter has now been settled with the respondent before Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre *vide* settlement agreement dated



19.10.2025 and copy of the said settlement agreement has been placed on record. In view of the same, he seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent does not dispute the aforesaid fact of settlement.

5. Leave granted.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.

7. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
