ORDER

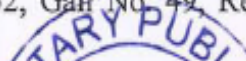

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1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the Delhi Jal Board ("DJB"), to provide supply of uninterrupted/continuous clean water to the petitioners' premises at 1st and 4th floors of the property bearing No. 49/4652 Reghar Pura, Karol Bagh, New Delhi-110005.
2. A Status Report dated 07th November, 2025, has been filed on behalf of the DJB, relevant portions of which, read as under:

"xxx xxx xxx

2. It is submitted that in compliance of the directions passed by this Hon'ble Court vide its Order dated 18.11.2025, the matter regarding the water supply issue at the residence of the Petitioner i.e. Sh. R.Madhav Bera, resident of House No. 4652, Gali No. 49, Regharpura, Karol





Bagh, New Delhi, has been examined and discussed with him personally by the officials of the Respondent.

3. It is submitted that at present, the water supply at his residence/ subject property is normal. It is further submitted that it has been assured to the Petitioner that water tanker supply shall be provided by the Delhi Jal Board as and when required to ensure uninterrupted water availability.
4. This status report is being submitted accordingly.

3. Perusal of the aforesaid Status Report shows that the water supply to the petitioners' residence has been restored and is normal. Further, DJB has also assured that water tanker shall be supplied to the petitioners in case of any disruption in the water supply.

4. Considering the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

5. Needless to state that, in case, the petitioners have any fresh cause of action in the future, the petitioners are at liberty to seek their remedies, in accordance with law.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition, along with the pending application, is accordingly disposed of.
