ORDER

1. A Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner for grant of Parole for a period of sixty days in case FIR No.417/2021 under Section 307/308 IPC, P.S. Badarpur.

2. It is submitted that the Petitioner was convicted by the Court of learned ASJ on 12.11.2024 and sentenced to imprisonment for five years. Criminal Appeal No.178/2025 filed before this Court was dismissed on 01.07.2025. The Petitioner filed an Application for Parole vide Dispatch No.574 to the Respondent, but no reply has been received till date.

3. Learned APP for State has filed the copy of the Order dated 12.09.2025 whereby the Parole Application has been rejected in view of the Rule 1210 Sub Rule 1 of Delhi Prison Rules. The Nominal Roll of the Petitioner filed in the Court today, which be taken on record.

Submissions heard.

4. The Parole is sought essentially for filing the Appeal and for taking



care of the new born child and the family members. The Petitioner has already undergone more than 2 years 7 months punishment which is more than half of the sentence.

5. Considering the totality of circumstances, the Petitioner is granted Parole for a period of four weeks on the following terms and conditions: -

- i. The Petitioner shall furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent.
- ii. The Petitioner shall report to the SHO of the local area once a week on every Sunday between 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM during the period of Parole.
- iii. The Petitioner shall furnish a telephone/mobile number to the Jail Superintendent as well as SHO of local police station, on which he can be contacted, if required. The said telephone number shall be kept active and operational at all the times by the Petitioner.
- iv. The Petitioner shall ordinarily reside at the address mentioned in the Petition.
- v. Immediately upon the expiry of period of Parole, the Petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent.
- vi. The period of Parole shall be counted from the day when the Petitioner is released from jail.

6. The Petition stands disposed of.
