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Matter taken up today as 25.11.2025 was declared a holiday on account of Guru Teg Bahadur's Martyrdom Day.

1. In furtherance of last order, learned counsel for petitioner on instructions seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all grounds as raised in the present petition before the trial court during final arguments. The order impugned in the present case was dismissal of the application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC and there having been no stay, the trial proceedings continued and have now reached the stage of final arguments. In terms with the legal position laid down in the case of *Anokhe Lal vs. Radha Mohan Bansal & Ors.*, (1996) 6 SCC 730, it would be desirable that the issue be decided on the basis of evidence brought on



record during trial.

2. Under these circumstances, the present petition and the accompanying applications are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as sought. Needless to say that while considering the issue on the basis of evidence brought on record, the learned trial court shall decide the matter uninfluenced by the impugned order.
