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1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A (4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a further period of seven months from 23.09.2025 to make and publish the final Award.
2. It is stated that the matter is at the final stage of cross-examination and due to voluminous nature of the arbitration record, there was some delay.
