1. The present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeks quashing of FIR No. 823/2022, registered at P.S. Jyoti Nagar for the offence under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
2. Upon conclusion of investigation, chargesheet was filed, wherein the Petitioners' names have been mentioned in Column No. 12.
3. Counsel for the Petitioners submits that the main accused and the Complainant in the subject FIR have amicably settled their dispute, and as such, nothing survives in the FIR.
4. In light of the foregoing, counsel for the Petitioners states that he



would like to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to take recourse to appropriate remedies, should the offence not be compounded and the proceedings not be closed.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
