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1. By way of the present petition, the petitioner is seeking release of the petitioner on emergency parole for a period of three weeks, in case arising out of FIR bearing no. 77/2001, registered at Police Station New Ashok Nagar, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 302/307/392/120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereafter 'IPC').
2. Issue notice. Mr. Rahul Tyagi, ASC for the State accepts notice.
3. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the petitioner has also filed an application for grant of emergency parole for a period of three weeks before the competent authority, and thus, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
4. Heard.
5. The concerned competent authority is directed to decide the application of the petitioner for emergency parole, within a period of one



week (irrespective of the holidays) from date, under intimation to the petitioner herein.

6. Let the copy of this order be sent by the Registry of this Court, to the concerned Jail Superintendent for compliance today itself.

7. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid direction, and with liberty to approach this Court afresh in case of any grievance.
