1. It is submitted by learned counsel for the parties, that both the matters have been settled and the terms of settlement have been recorded *vide* settlement agreements dated 14.05.2025 and the same have been placed on record.
2. Order XXIII, Rule 3 authorises the Court to pass a decree on a compromise wherein the parties to the dispute have made an arrangement to



settle the dispute. It has been comprehensively stated in the provision that the settlement arrived at should meet the essentials laid down therein, namely, (i) the compromise is lawful (ii) it is reduced in writing (iii) it is duly signed by the parties arriving at the compromise.

3. The settlement has been agreed upon without fear or coercion and the parties appear to have entered into the settlement agreement on their own volition.

4. The Court is satisfied that the settlement has been arrived at between the parties following due procedure and meeting the essentials specified Order XXIII, Rule 3. Therefore, the parties shall be bound by the aforesaid settlement agreement.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the civil suit stands decreed in terms of the settlement agreement.

6. The Registry is directed to draw-up a decree sheet. Let the settlement agreements be form part of the decree.

7. The civil suit along with the pending applications stands disposed of
