1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 2(b) and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers:

“i) Initiate appropriate civil contempt proceedings against the respondents and punish the Contempts / respondents accordingly;

ii) Pass appropriate orders / directions to the Contemptor / Respondent no. 1 and 2 to comply / directions passed by this Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 16.04.2024;

iii) Pass such further or other orders which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”

3. Status report dated 08.03.2025 has been filed on behalf of the MCD, wherein it has been recorded as under:



“10. That pursuant to aforesaid demolition / sealing orders already passed in respect of the subject properly the Building Department -II of South Zone - MCD has also tried /taken / carried out the necessary action as per details given herein below:

S.No.	Date of Action	Action Taken
1.	03/05/2024	Action could not be taken due to shortage of time.
2.	31/05/2024	Upon availability of police force, 02 RCC panels demolished and cut at Stilt floor slab, further defaced all floors and internal brick walls also demolished. After taking the said action the entire building has been sealed by putting seal at 01 point at the entrance of the building at Stilt floor.

The Photographs taken during the aforesaid demolition/sealing action are annexed herewith as **Annexure-G (Colly).**”

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the present petition.
5. The present petition is disposed of as not pressed.
6. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
