ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* to direct the respondent to secure and produce the body of the Petitioner's daughter-in-law, Ms 'P'.
2. Learned Standing Counsel for State appears on advance notice and submits that the missing girl, Ms 'P' is appearing through video conferencing.

5. Permission and liberty, as prayed for, is granted in accordance with law.
6. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
