1. It is the claim of the petitioner that the articles which were seized by respondent no.1 under Section 19 of the *Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014* have not been released in its entirety.
2. He claims that certain articles are still with the respondent-MCD and are not released.
3. We permit the petitioner to approach the respondent-MCD with details of the articles which, in his view, are in the custody of the respondent.
4. After hearing the petitioner, the respondent may pass a reasoned order



as regards the release of the articles.

5. Let the aforesaid exercise be completed within a period of four weeks from today.
6. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
8. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
