1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner, challenging the Order dated 12.10.2024 passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, (hereinafter referred to as 'Tribunal'), in Contempt Petition No. 806/2024 in Original Application No. 3157/2024, titled ***Kore Nihal Pramod v.
