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I.A. 9384/2025 (u/O XXIII Rule 3 seeking recordal of the settlement arrived at between the parties)

1. This joint application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff and defendants under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') along with supporting affidavits, to record terms of settlement arrived at between the parties.
2. The application bears the signatures of the authorised representatives of the plaintiff as well as the defendants and their respective counsel. The application is also supported by affidavits of the authorised representatives of the plaintiff as well as the defendants.
