1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking directions against the respondent authorities to enforce *status quo* orders passed by the trial Court in certain litigation involving private parties.
4. Needless to say, the concerned Civil Court has the jurisdiction to enforce the *status quo* order or any other interim orders that have been



passed by it. In these proceedings, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, it would be inapposite to issue any directions with regard thereto.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate civil remedies. Needless to say, in the event of such remedy is being availed, the concerned Civil Court shall bestow urgent consideration to the same.

6. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
