ORDER

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1. A Writ Petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner for directing the Respondents not to arrest the Petitioner in relation to summons dated 21.10.2024 and any subsequent summons which may be issued.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that the Petitioner has already joined the investigations. The prayers are essentially in the nature of seeking Bail which is beyond the reliefs that can be claimed under Article 226 Constitution of India.

3. The Petition is disposed of with liberty to the Petitioner to approach the learned Trial Court for appropriate relief. However, the protection from arrest is extended to the Petitioner for 15 days to enable him to approach the learned Trial Court.



4. The Writ Petition stands disposed of.
