7. It is submitted that the Petitioner/Applicant is seeking Regular Bail on the medical grounds of his mother and seeks permission to withdraw the Bail Application with liberty to file afresh before the learned Trial Court.

8. In view of the submissions made, the Bail Application is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
