2. The present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers:-

“a. initiate contempt proceedings against the contemnor for willfully, knowingly and deliberately violating the order dated 09.09.2025 in W.P. (C) No. 2882 of 2025 in total disregard to the dignity of this Hon’ble Court; And / Or;

b. impose a fine on contemnor for such amount(s) as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper for blatantly and deliberately violating the order dated 09.09.2025 in W.P. (C) No. 2882 of 2025; And / Or;

c. pass an order against contemnor thereby imposing an adequate punishment as per Section 12 of the Contempt of



Courts Act, 1971; And / Or;

d. pass any other or further relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case may also be granted against the contemnor.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order has been complied with and in view of the same, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
4. Leave granted.
5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
