1. After the writ petition was disposed of on 17th December 2025, the contemptuous conduct of the petitioner noticed by this Court prompted us to pass an order directing action including under the Contempt of Courts Act, *vide* speaking order dated 04th November 2025.
2. The Court, thereafter, in view of the joint request deferred the hearing of the contempt proceedings.
3. Respective counsel appearing for the parties including that of Society informs that all the issues *inter se* in relation to the petitioners and the neighbours, so also the Society in the matter of maintenance of the



apartment are sorted out.

4. Counsel appearing for the Society states that he has no objection, in case, the contempt notice is discharged.
5. Senior Counsel for the petitioner has stated, on instructions, that all the allegations against the Society and its office-bearers, including that of neighbours, will be withdrawn unconditionally as the issues are amicably sorted out.
6. Statement is accepted.
7. We further accept the unconditional apology tendered by the petitioner.
8. Accordingly, we discharge the contempt notices.
9. The present application stands disposed of accordingly.
