3. Criminal Petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*hereinafter referred to as 'B.N.S.S.'*) (*corresponding to Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973*), has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, with the prayer that the Charge Sheet in FIR No. 1207/2015 registered at Police Station Vasant Vihar, be filed immediately before the learned Trial Court and further directions be given to the learned Trial Court, to ensure that the trial commences at the earliest and proceeds strictly within a fixed time-bound schedule.
4. Learned APP appeared on advance Notice for the State and submits, on instructions from the IO, that the Charge-Sheet had to be reconstructed



and is likely to be filed within two weeks.

5. In view of the submissions made by the learned APP, no further directions are required.
6. Needless to say that every Court is cognizant that the trial is to be proceeded expeditiously. No directions in this regard are merited.
7. The Petition is disposed of accordingly.
