2. This is an application under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (old Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., 1973) seeks regular bail in case FIR No. 476/2023, under Sections 498A/304B/34 of the IPC, registered at P.S. Jyoti Nagar.
