1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a further period of 1 year for making and publishing the final Award.
2. It is stated that only the Arbitral Award is required to be rendered by the Arbitral Tribunal.
