1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. For redressal of his grievances, the petitioner has made several complaints to the MCD which has been enclosed alongwith the writ petition.

same shall also be taken by the MCD, within a period of two months from today, of course, after giving a notice to the party who may be affected by such intended action.

5. The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
