1. This petition under Article 227 of the Constitution, assails the order dated 08.10.2025 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal [“the Tribunal”] in MACT 276/2022 titled “*Sunita Devi & Ors. v. Sandeep Sharma & Ors.*”, whereby the petitioner’s application seeking recall of a witness for cross-examination, has been dismissed.
2. Mr. A.K. Soni, learned counsel for the petitioner – Liberty General Insurance Co. Ltd., submits that, in the interregnum, the claim petition itself has been disposed of by the Tribunal *vide* judgment dated 15.10.2025. Although a copy of the judgment is not yet available on



record, the said information has been ascertained from the Tribunal's website.

3. In light of this position, Mr. Soni submits that the present petition stands rendered infructuous, while reserving the petitioner's right to assail the award, if any, on all available grounds.

4. The petition, alongwith pending application, is therefore, disposed of in these terms.
