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1. *Vide* order dated 23.09.2025, the division bench of this Court has passed the following order.

"1. The present Appeal has been preferred under Section 10 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966, assailing the Judgment dated 17.01.2023 passed by the learned Single Judge in CS (OS) No. 1587 of 2011, whereby the application filed by the Appellants under Order XII Rule 6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, was dismissed.
