1. The limited grievance canvassed by the petitioner is that the concerned Appellate Authority (Ld. Divisional Commissioner, No.5, Sham Nath Marg, Delhi-110054) be directed to expeditiously decide the petitioner's Appeal No. 956/2024 titled ***Seema Kochhar v. Benu Kochhar & Ors***, filed under Rule 22(3)(4) of the Delhi Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Rules, 2009.
2.
