1. The present application under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023¹ (corresponding to Sections 439 and 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973²) seeks regular bail in the proceedings arising from FIR No. 290/2021 dated 13th May, 2021, registered under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860³ at P.S. Sarai Rohilla.

2. In this case, the trial has concluded, as the case is presently at the stage of final arguments, as confirmed by Mr. Hemant Mehla, APP for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer.

3. In these circumstances, the Court is of the opinion that the Petitioner should await the verdict rather than seek bail at this advanced stage of the

proceedings. Any observations made at this juncture may potentially affect the rights of either party. The Court, therefore, finds no basis to entertain the present petition at this stage.

4. The Trial Court is requested to conclude the final arguments at the earliest and render its judgment preferably within three months from the date of conclusion of the arguments.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of along with pending applications.
