1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.
2. The Application stands disposed of.

3. A Petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the Petitioners seeking quashing of the proceedings in case FIR No.838/2015 under Section 498A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Madhu Vihar, Delhi on the ground that the allegations of cruelty have been not accepted either in the Divorce Petition which has stood finalized or in the Domestic Violence Petition, where also the allegations of cruelty have not been accepted. It is on the same ground that the Chargesheet has been filed and which is liable to be quashed.
4. As per the submissions of the learned Counsel for the Petitioner



himself, an Order on Charge has been passed which has not been challenged.

5. The quashing has been sought on the grounds on which the Petitioner has arrived to challenge the Order on Charge.

6. The Petition is disposed of along with the pending Application(s), with liberty to the Petitioner to avail his remedy under the law.

7. The learned counsel for the Petition is at liberty to place those judgments before the learned Revisional Court in accordance with law.
