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1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 29A (4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner seeks extension of the mandate of the Arbitral for concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal has expired on 31.12.2024.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent, on instructions, submits that the respondent has no objection to the prayer made in the petition.
