ORDER

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1. The petitioner is essentially aggrieved that his application seeking emergency parole, though was filed long back on 25.10.2025, has not been decided till date.
2. Undisputedly, in terms of Rule 1213 of the Delhi Prisons Rule, 2018 ('DPR'), any application seeking parole is required to be decided within a period of four weeks.
3. More than four weeks have elapsed since the filing of the application by the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the respondent authorities to decide the petitioner's application within a period of one week from date.
5. Considering that the ground for seeking release was



medical emergency expressed by the petitioner, the respondent authorities are expected not to delay the disposal of the application.

6. Copy of the order be communicated to the concerned Jail Superintendent for necessary compliance.

7. Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court in case any grievance remains in future.
