ORDER

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1. Learned Counsel for the Respondent draws attention of this Court to the communications dated 04.09.2025 and 29.10.2025 sent by the Respondent to the Petitioner, to state that it is open for the Petitioner to complete the remedial work within a period of two months. 7. It is always open for the Petitioner to approach this Court again, in case need arises in future.
