2. According to *Ms. Puja S. Kalra*, Standing Counsel for MCD, petitioner's case can be disposed of on the same terms as reflected in the aforesaid order.
3. In that view of the matter, having regard to the prayer of petitioner seeking directions to respondent for issuance of Certificate of Vending



(COV) and restraining respondent from taking any action against petitioner, we deem it appropriate to direct respondent to verify the credentials of petitioner based on documents. For this purpose, we permit petitioner to appear before the *Assistant Commissioner (General Branch), MCD*, on 15th December 2025.
