1. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with the following prayer:

- (i) *Direct/issue Writ of Mandamus to the respondent No. 1 to 5 to do their duty and take appropriate action to register an FIR against the respondent No. 4-6 and carry out the investigation in fair and impartial manner;*
- (ii) *Direct to issue writ of Certiorari to call for records from the respondent No. 2 to 5 for its perusal and necessary action;*
- (iii) *Direct to issue any writ/direction/order in favour of petitioner society and against the respondents, in the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice.*

2. After part submissions, Mr. C.S.S. Tomar, learned counsel who



appears for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file appropriate complaint before the trial court along with application under Section 175(3) BNSS (erstwhile 156(3) CrPC).

3. The statement made by learned counsel is taken on record and petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
