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1. By way of present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the registration granted to respondent no.3, namely, Hamdard Education Society.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in spite of the fact that the petitioner furnished a representation seeking cancellation of the registration granted to respondent No. 3, nothing has been done.
3. According to us, the dispute is as to whether registration of respondent no. 3 has been given rightly or authorisedly or there was any fraud committed by respondent no. 3 cannot be decided by Writ Court in



exercise of its powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

4. The petitioner has to avail statutory remedy available under the provision of CGST/DGST Act, 2017 in this regard.

5. While giving the liberty to the petitioner to avail statutory remedy, the writ petition with all pending applications is disposed of.
